

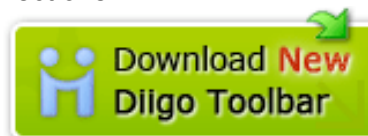

Start Here!**

1. You can install the diigo toolbar on your home/school computer. This toolbar will allow you to bookmark, highlight, and comment on web sites that you can add to your account.

2. First, go to www.diigo.com. (Watch the video again if you'd like a refresher of diigo's tools.)

3. Go to the upper right hand corner and login using your email address and password.

4. In the lower right hand corner of your Dashboard, locate green "Download Toolbar." Click on it and follow the directions.



7. You can search your bookmarks by "List" or "Titles." But you can also search by "Tags." (See tag cloud below.)

6. When you are adding a bookmark, be sure to add a title and tags. (Use the recommended tags as a guide.)

Assign the bookmark to a list if you wish.

OR

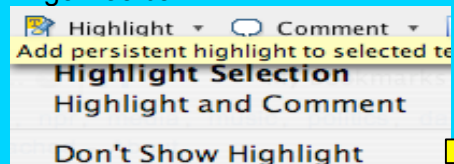
2nd way: Go to the web site you wish to save. Once there, click on "Bookmark" on the browser's Diigo Toolbar and click "Bookmark This Page"



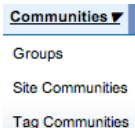
5. Then there are 2 ways you can bookmark a page.

1st way: Click on "My Bookmarks" and go to the upper right hand corner and click on "Add a Bookmark" by typing in the URL you wish to bookmark.

8. Highlight & Comment on a page by selecting the desired text on a particular site and go to "Highlight" or "Comment" on the Diigo Toolbar.



9. Another feature of diigo is networking with others. Go to "Communities" & then "Groups" on the top search bar.



Explore the Groups in Diigo or create your own Group.

10. Once you find a Group that you are interested in, click on "Join Group" and follow the directions.



11. Or if you'd like to find friends, go to "Friends" on the blue search bar and then "Find Friends."

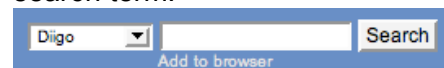
Just type in your friend's name or email address.

12. To search your bookmarks or others' bookmarks, go to the search box on the upper right side of the page. Enter your search term.

Social Bookmarking is a great Web 2.0 tool for educators. Use websites like diigo, del.icio.us, Furl, or Citeulike to save, organize, annotate and share your favorite educational web sites.

diigo can take your bookmarking one step further, so you can HIGHLIGHT and COMMENT (and then save) specific details of a web site.

Professional Use:

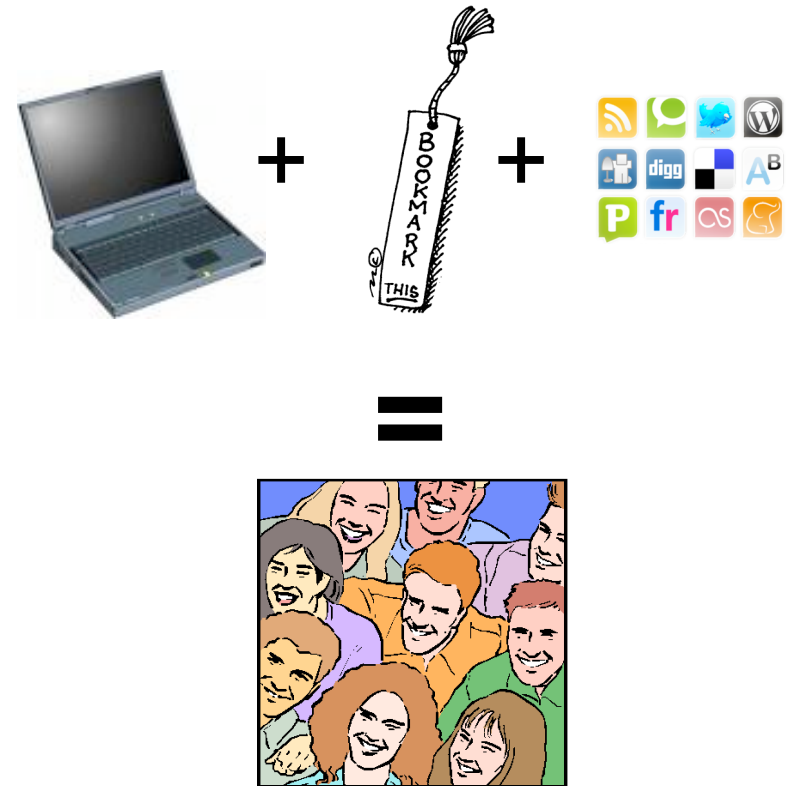
*Research * Educational Resources
